

Interview with Herr Willy Ewers, formerly on Armaments Staff and, before the war, owner of a large factory. Used at present by Captain McGranahan, and comes with a long report on the first 16 numbers of the Frankfurterische Rundschau.

General criticism has to do with placing too much stress on news relating to Nazi atrocities, to bad handling by Germans of slave labor, etc. Generally apologist attitude. Stresses strongly difference between Nazis and others. Talks English well. No definite ideas, and believes has a good line on popular reactions through his contacts when he was P.W. at Saizburg, and conversations with people in Frankfort.
